#### 1. Definition of

- a. Original language uses EKKLESIA, which was a common term used by the people at that time to describe their official 'assemblies.'
- b. The word literally means 'to call out,' so it really fits the idea of the assembly of the saved because God has 'called you out of darkness into His marvelous light' 1 Pet. 2:9.

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- a. Matthew 16:13-18, "Upon this rock I will build my church."

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- This is the first use of "church" after the ascension of Jesus Christ.
- Somewhere between Jesus' promise to *build* the church and Acts 5:11's reference to the *already-existing* church, the church had come into being.

## 5. The Local Church is Organized and Autonomous (Self-Ruled)

- b. Other than Jesus Himself, there is no higher governing organization above and beyond the local congregation.

- c. Acts 15 The church at Antioch sent representatives to the church at Jerusalem to discuss and decide on a "sharp dispute" about Gentile Christians and the Law of Moses.
